Note to Competitors

1. **Booking In** begins 30 minutes prior to the start of each section. Each competitor is required to advise the String Division of the title of each piece being performed and the composer of each piece for every section they compete in. Competitors will be advised how this process will take place at a later date.
2. Where possible, all competitors are encouraged to use an **original copy** of the music for their performance. Music for the Adjudicator is to be clearly named and the page marked where there is a volume of work.
3. Competitors are required to complete a **Copyright Declaration Form**. The form can be downloaded from [Copyright Declaration Form](#).
4. Where appropriate all performances must be accompanied. Rule No 7.
5. It is the RESPONSIBILITY of the competitor to collect any **deposit refund** due when booking in the music just prior to the performance.
6. Any **withdrawals** are to be made via text to 0415 298 067 or email to aesstringsconvenor@gmail.com Withdrawals are NOT to be made through the Adelaide Eisteddfod Office or the Booking-In area as they may not reach the Convenor in time. Rule 31 states that all withdrawals are to be made at least 24 hours in advance. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the next scheduled section the competitor has entered.

Adjudicators

Sharon Grigoryan

Cellist Sharon Grigoryan moved to Adelaide in 2013 to take up the position as cellist with the Australian String Quartet - a position she held until December 2020. Prior to this, she was a member of the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra and Melbourne Chamber Orchestra. She has been guest principal cellist of the Adelaide and Tasmanian Symphony Orchestras. From 2011 Sharon toured regularly, both nationally and internationally with the Australian Chamber Orchestra, and whilst living in Berlin in 2012 Sharon performed with the Mahler Chamber Orchestra and Spira Mirabilis Chamber Orchestra. Sharon is the artistic director of the "Barossa, Baroque and Beyond" Festival, performs with the Australian World Orchestra, and plays in a duo with guitarist and husband Slava Grigoryan.

Alison Rayner

Violinist Alison Rayner was born and raised in Adelaide. After graduating with a Bachelor of Music Performance from Adelaide University she moved to Melbourne to take up a permanent position with the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra. She has also held the position of Associate Principal second violin with the Adelaide Symphony Orchestra. From 2011 she was based in Oslo, Norway, where she was a member of Oslo Philharmonic Orchestra's first violin section. During her time in Oslo, she performed with the Norwegian Chamber Orchestra and appeared regularly in the Oslo Philharmonic's chamber music series, playing both violin and viola. She has attended chamber music workshops at Stanford University in California and at the Banff Centre for Arts in Alberta, Canada. Alison has been performing with the Australian World Orchestra since 2014. In 2021 she moved back to her hometown of Adelaide, where she is now teaching and performing.

Special Awards

The Norwood Symphony Orchestra Prize

A Medallion and \$150 will be awarded to an instrumental concerto contestant or a vocal contestant finalist who may be invited to perform with the Norwood Symphony Orchestra at a later date.

Mitcham Orchestra / Mitcham Rotary Club Prize

A Medallion and \$150 will be awarded to a junior instrumentalist who may be invited to perform with the Mitcham Orchestra at a later date.

The Music Teachers Association of SA Inc. /Grace Barbara Turner Awards for Excellence in Performance

Four awards of \$100 will be made to competitors, one from each of the following Divisions: Keyboard, Strings, Wind and Vocal. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

The Australian Strings Association Award

A plaque will be awarded to the most outstanding competitor for Violin, Viola, Cello or Double Bass 18 years or under.

The Jane Peters Violin Medallion

Awarded to the most promising violinist 16 years or under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

The David Bishop Cello Medallion

Awarded for the most promising cellist 16 years and under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

The Adele Anthony Violin Medallion

Awarded to the most outstanding violinist 13 years or under. Competitors must have performed as a soloist.

MBS Young Virtuoso Award SA

Competitors from the Adelaide Eisteddfod S939 String Player Recital may be selected to compete in the MBS Young Virtuoso Award, offered by the Australian Fine Music Network of community radio stations. The adjudicators will select the SA finalists through Recitals offered via the Piano, String, Flute and Woodwind Divisions and performances in the Vocal Division.
